The State of Michigan owns one third of the island, which includes the lighthouse complex under the jurisdiction of the Department of Natural Resources (DNR).

In 2004 FILA was formed to work in partnership with the DNR to preserve the lighthouse station. Unique features include having TWO towers on the island, and 7 out buildings.
